#### **RELEASE OF LIABILITY**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Hours of Park are 6am to 9pm daily
- 2. No vicious dogs allowed. All fights between dogs must be attended to by the dog's owners.
- 3. Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries or damages caused by them.
- 4. Owners must be inside the fenced area at all times while their dogs are in the off leash area. Dogs are not to be left in the park unattended.
- 5. Leash laws apply outside the fenced area.
- 6. Children under 15 are not allowed in the fenced area unless accompanied by a responsible, legal adult.
- 7. Dogs must have proof of rabies vaccination or approved titers from a licensed veterinarian.
- 8. Gates must remain closed except when entering or exiting the off leash or staging areas.
- 9. No choke, pinch or spike collars allowed in the park area. Dogs must wear leather or smooth cloth collars while in the off leash area.
- 10. Limit: 3 dogs per person at any time.
- 11. KEEP PARK AREA CLEAN! Pick up your dog's poop. Place all dog waste and trash in designated receptacles.
- 12. NOT ALLOWED IN THE SOULARD DOG PARK:
  - a. Dogs in heat
  - b. Vicious dogs
  - c. Animals other than dogs
  - d. Puppies under 4 months old
  - e. Dogs that are injured or in poor health
  - f. Glass of any kind
  - g. Food of any kind
  - h. Bikes, rollerblades, scooters, etc.
  - i. Smoking

I further understand that dogs, irrespective of their trainings and usual past behavior or characteristics, may act or react unpredictably at times based upon instinct or circumstances, and I agree to assume the risk of injury to me, any individual accompanying me in *the Dog Park*, and my dog (s). I understand that the risk may result from fierce, aggressive, vicious, and dangerous dogs, which may be present in *the Dog Park*. If further understand and assume the risk that not all dogs present in *the Dog Park* have received the Rabies vaccine as required by law, and that not all dogs using *the Dog Park* have been vaccinated for Distemper or Parvo, all of which could result in injuries to humans and other dogs; dog theft or unlawful capture; dog escape over or under fences; plants and/or water sources in the park may be poisonous to dogs; park vegetation may have burrs or seeds that could become tangled in a dog's coat or lodge in a dog's feet, ears, nose, or eyes; mosquitoes, ticks, chiggers, fleas or other insects and animals may be present in the park, all of which might injure or infect my dog (s). I understand and expressly assume all additional risks.

I hereby acknowledge that I voluntarily have applied to participate and use, with my dog(s), the John and Lucille Wendling Soulard Dog Park (hereafter referred to as "the Dog Park".) I understand that the act of unleashing my dog (s) and being

physically present inside the Dog Park necessarily involves risks of injury to me, other people, my dog (s), and other dogs, which

It is my understanding that no agent or employee of the Dog Park will supervise the Dog Park at any time. I further understand that the Frenchtown Dog Park Association does not assume liability for loss, damage, for any kind of injury sustained by any human or dog while using the Dog Park. I, therefore, expressly assume all risks associated with using the Dog Park, as well as fixtures and equipment located therein, in an unsupervised manner.

By signing this release of liability and using *the Dog Park*, I hereby fully and forever release and discharge the Frenchtown Dog Park Association their employees and agents from any and all claims, demands, damages, rights of action, or causes of action present or future, whether the same be known or unknown, anticipated or unanticipated, resulting from or arising out of my use or intended use of said John and Lucille Wendling Soulard Dog Park. I fully and forever release and discharge Frenchtown Dog Park Association, and their employees and agents from any and all negligent acts and omissions in the same, and intend to be legally bound by this lease.

I have carefully read this release of liability and understand and fully agree with its contents. I also have received a copy of the brochure outlining rules for use, etiquette for dog owners and recommendations for dog owners.

#### Participant Agreement & Release Form

(All attendees must sign a release form in order to participate in Sheepiepalooza)

I agree to keep my dog(s) under control at all times and will not tolerate aggressive behavior towards other dogs or people, including but not limited to snapping, lunging and biting. I understand that if my dog exhibits any of these behaviors repeatedly I may be asked at the very least to keep the dog on leash even in off leash situations, muzzle it or crate it. I agree to comply with such requests in order to continue my participation in Sheepiepalooza.

I also understand that off leash play areas, such as the dog park, are designated for play time for the dogs and those opportunities are limited throughout the event. If my dog does not like to play or interferes with other dogs efforts to play amicably I agree to keep my dog by my side as necessary so as to allow the other participants the freedom to enjoy play time.

Even when not with the group, I agree to make socially responsible decisions that will not be harmful to others or potentially jeopardize the future use of facilities or prohibit the event from continuing in the future. I understand that if I choose to violate this agreement I may be asked to discontinue my current and future participation in Sheepiepalooza.
